

Culver CITY

The Culver City Municipal Code 5.01.010, Ordinance No 2001-011 Solid Waste Management states, "The Culver City Sanitation Division has the exclusive franchise for all solid and recyclable waste material handling within the City limits."

All city occupants who use bins or industrial drop bodies are required to obtain city issued containers from the Sanitation Division, who will arrange for their delivery, collection and removal. For more information, contact a Sanitation Customer Service Representative at (310) 253-6400

Those individuals who request to store their bins or industrial drop bodies in the public right-of way (generally the streets) are required to first obtain a permit from the Engineering Division located on the 2nd floor of City Hall, 9770 Culver Blvd., Culver City, CA 90232, (310) 253-5600. All permit requests are subject to a site survey.

PERMIT FEES \$534.00 Total

- \$90 per hour (with a two-hour minimum) inspection fee for street traffic safety.
- \$45 Issuance Fee.
- \$300.00 Refundable right-of-way damage deposit.

REFUSE COLLECTION FEES

Commercial Bins:

- 2-cubic yards: \$104.31 per month (Includes weekly refuse pickup.)
- 3-cubic yards: \$128.13 per month (Includes weekly refuse pickup.)

Temporary Bins:

- Delivery or Removal: \$8.01 per event for 2-yard bin or 3-yard bin
- Rental: \$42.20 per month for either a 2-or-3-yard bin (fess will be prorated for bins kept less than the full month)
- 2-yard bin \$26.70 per refuse pickup
- 3-yard bin \$40.07 per refuse pickup

Industrial Drop Bodies:

- \$156.12 per refuse pickup (Includes delivery, rental and removal.)
- Rental: \$137.80 per month for a 8, 10, 30, 40, 50-yard bin (fess will be prorated for bins kept less than the full month)
- Trash fees up to 11 tons \$77.76
- Trash fees over 11 tons \$155.53
- Call Customer Service for fees on other types of waste.

Special Bin Pickups: (Pickups made in addition to your regularly scheduled refuse pickup.)

- 2-yard bin \$26.70 per refuse pickup
- 3-yard bin \$40.07 per refuse pickup
