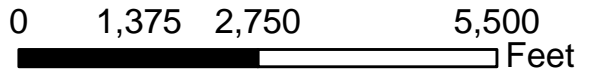
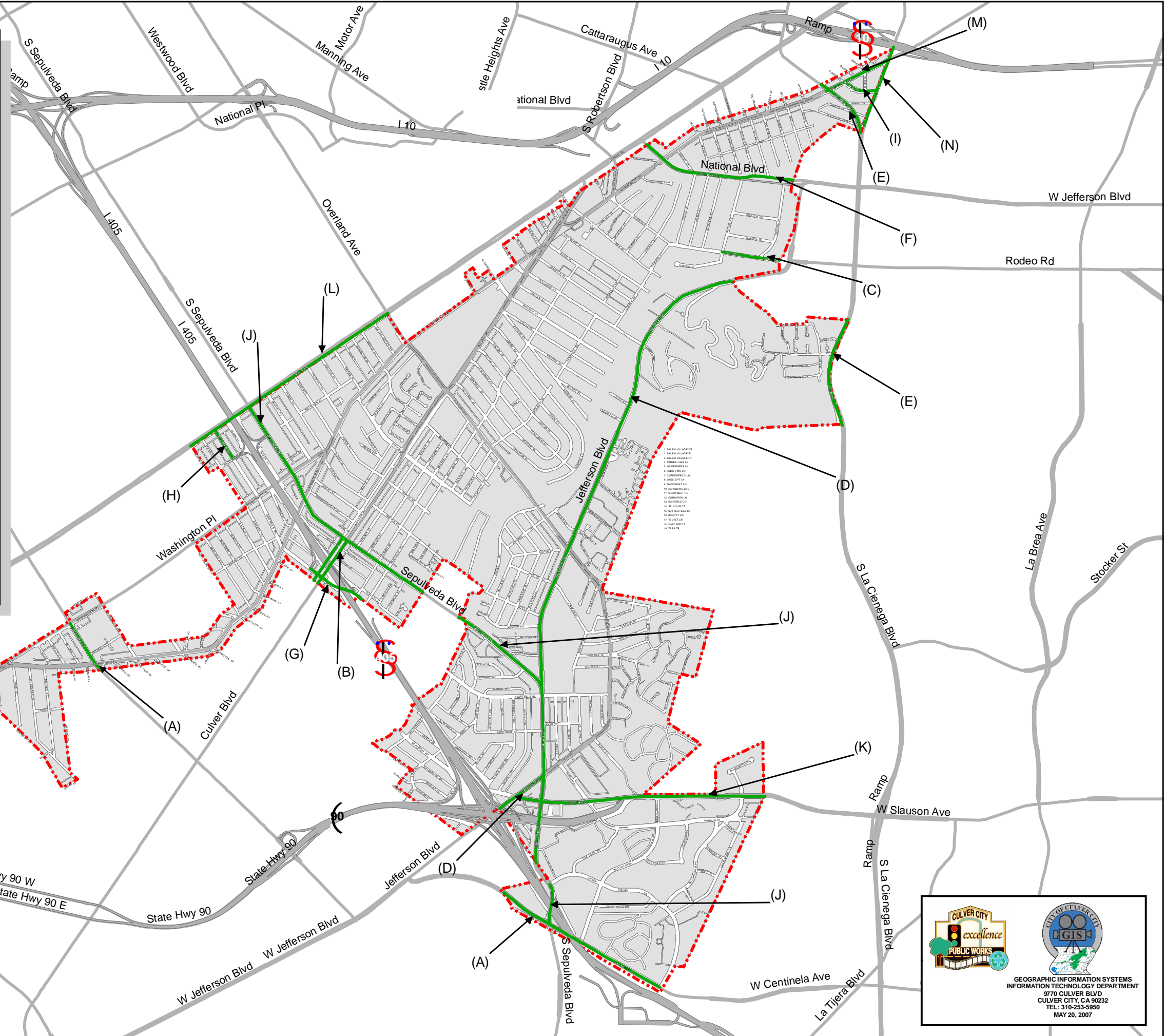

7.02.210 TRUCK ROUTES DESIGNATED

Any commercial vehicle, the laden or unladen weight of which exceeds six thousand (6000) pounds, shall use the following streets designated as truck routes:

- (A) Centinela Ave
- (B) Culver Blvd from Sepulveda Blvd to west City limit near Sawtelle Blvd
- (C) Higuera St between Hayden Ave/PI and Jefferson Blvd
- (D) Jefferson Blvd
- (E) La Cienega Blvd
- (F) National Blvd
- (G) Sawtelle Blvd between Culver/Washington off-ramp of the San Diego Fwy and Braddock Dr
- (H) Sawtelle Blvd between Matteson Ave and Venice Blvd
- (I) Adams Blvd between Washington Blvd and Fairfax Ave
- (J) Sepulveda Blvd
- (K) Slauson Ave from Jefferson Blvd to east City limit
- (L) Venice Blvd
- (M) Washington Blvd from La Cienega Blvd to east City limit at Fairfax Ave
- (N) West side of Fairfax Ave from La Cienega Blvd to north City limit

TRANSPORTATION PERMITS

WHY ARE TRANSPORTATION PERMITS NECESSARY?

Transportation Permits are issued for the mutual benefit of the City and the operators of oversize/overweight vehicles by:

- Restricting/prohibiting the use of streets or other infrastructures that could be damaged by oversize/overweight vehicles;
- Restricting/prohibiting the use of streets where conflicting construction activity, closures or special events are occurring;
- Restricting/prohibiting the use of streets that are not geometrically capable of accommodating certain commercial vehicles or loads.

VEHICLES OR ACTIVITIES REQUIRING A TRANSPORTATION PERMIT

Transportation Permits are required for all vehicles exceeding the limits of a legal load, as defined by the California Vehicle Code (CVC), and must be carried in the permitted vehicle at all times when said vehicle is being operated on public streets. The dimensions of a legal load are:

- 14 ft. 0 in. Height
- 8 ft. 6 in. Width
- 65 ft. 0 in. Length
- 80,000 lbs. Gross Weight

AUTHORITY

Division 15, Chapter 5, Article 6 of the CVC, permits the City to issue special permits to operate or move a vehicle or load exceeding the maximums specified in the CVC. A Transportation Permit issued by the City is only valid for streets in Culver City.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Certificate of Insurance, Liability Coverage. A valid policy of Bodily Injury and Property Damage Insurance, with expiration date, is required for vehicles operating on public roadways. The minimum policy limit is \$1,000,000 combined single limit coverage. The Certificate of Insurance must name the City of Culver City as "additional insured" on separate page, endorsement CG20 form and there must be a "30-day written cancellation clause." The cancellation language must be exactly as follows, unless authorized by the City Attorney's office:

"Should any of the above described policies be cancelled before the expiration date thereof, the issuing company will mail 30 days written notice to the certificate holder named to the left".

(Please note that "endeavor to mail" is not acceptable.)

In addition, the Applicant must possess a current City of Culver City business license. Exemptions to this requirement are when the carrier is driving through the City and does not stop within City limits. Another type of exemption is a "Vehicle for Hire" and the designation is made by the State.

Cost of Transportation Permits are as follows:
